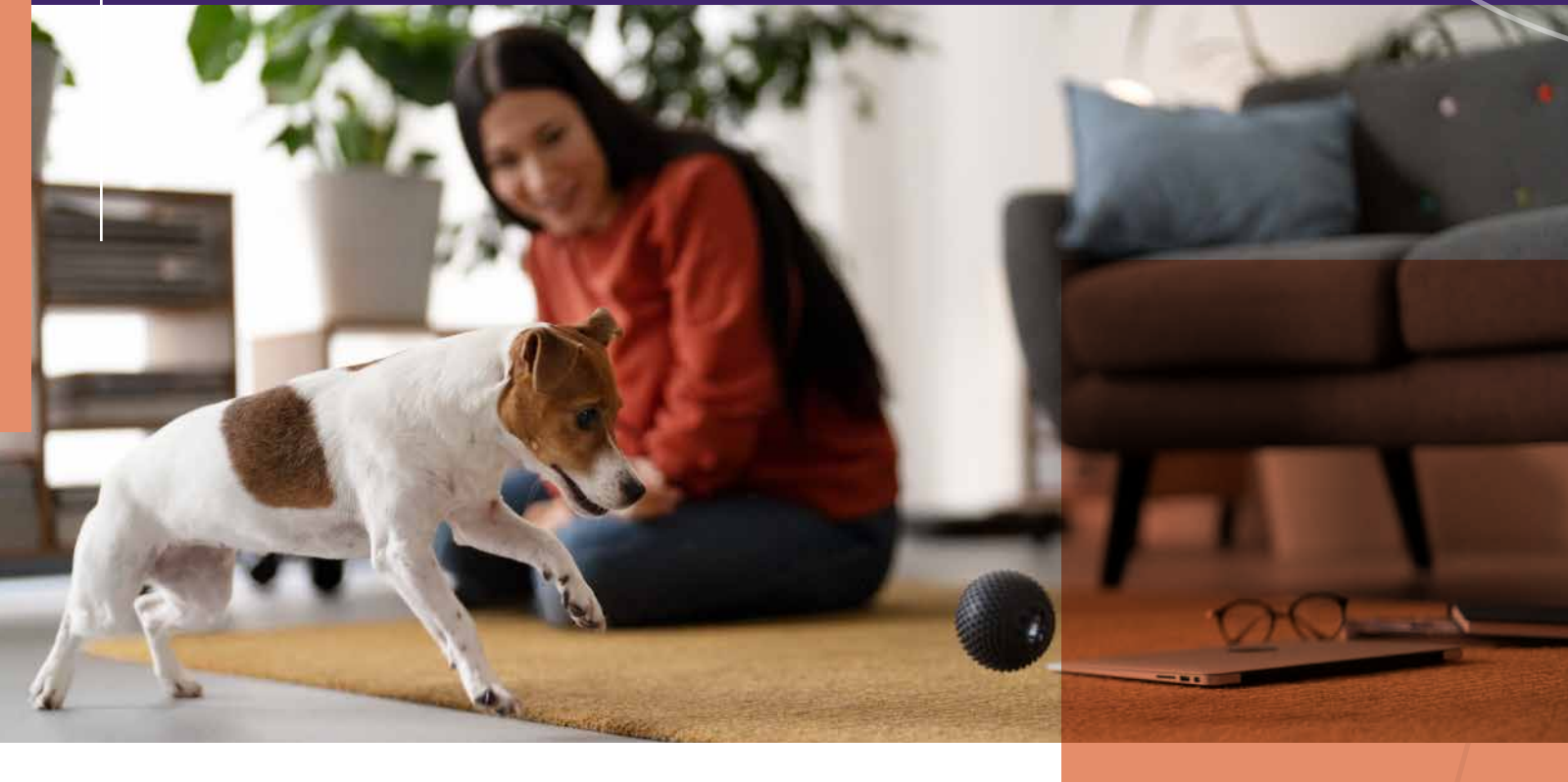

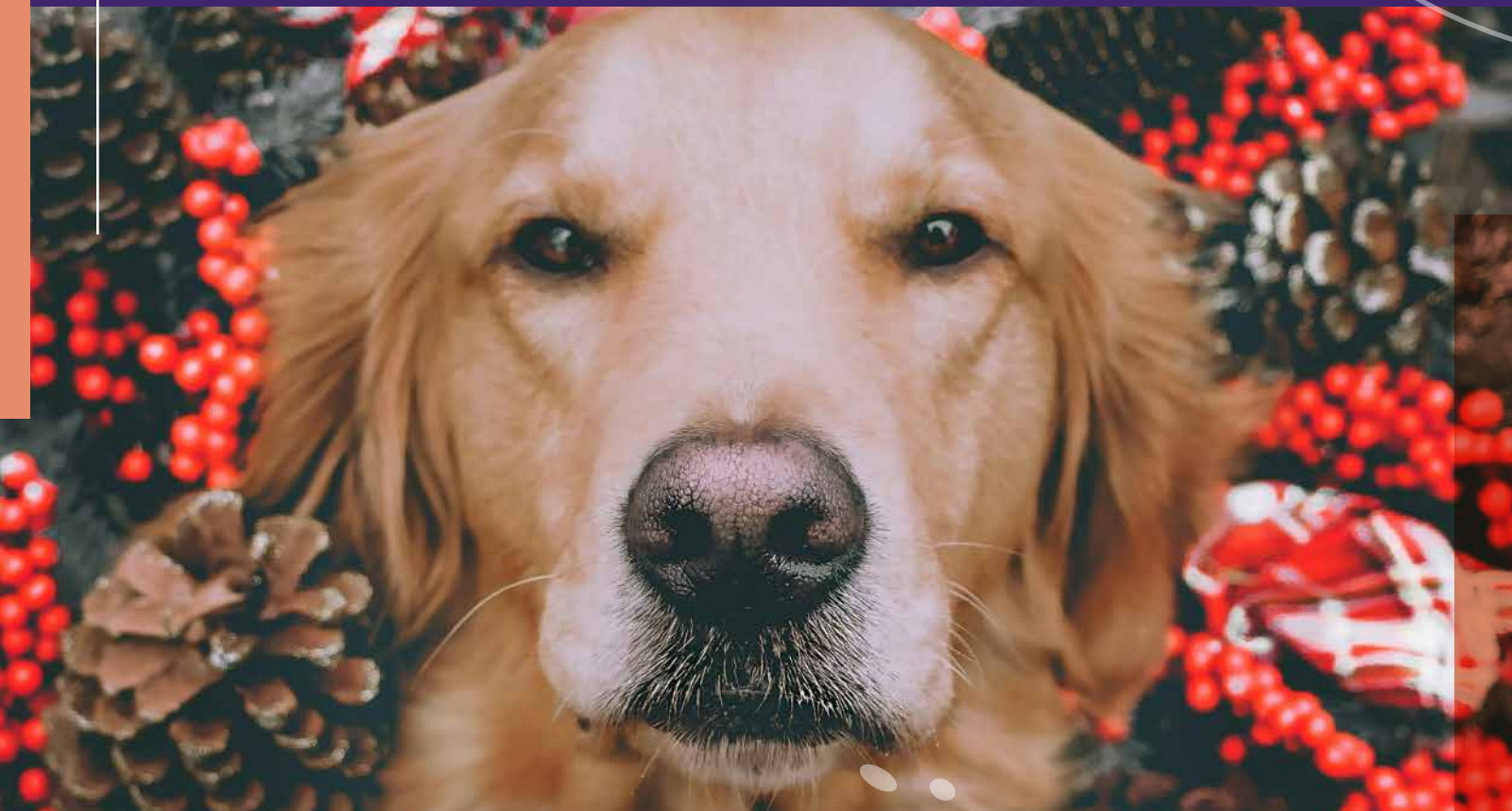
# Cats Are the Ultimate Contortionists

Each has its distinct pattern, making them unique. This natural identifier is becoming a useful tool in identifying lost pets, complementing traditional tags, tattoos, and microchips.

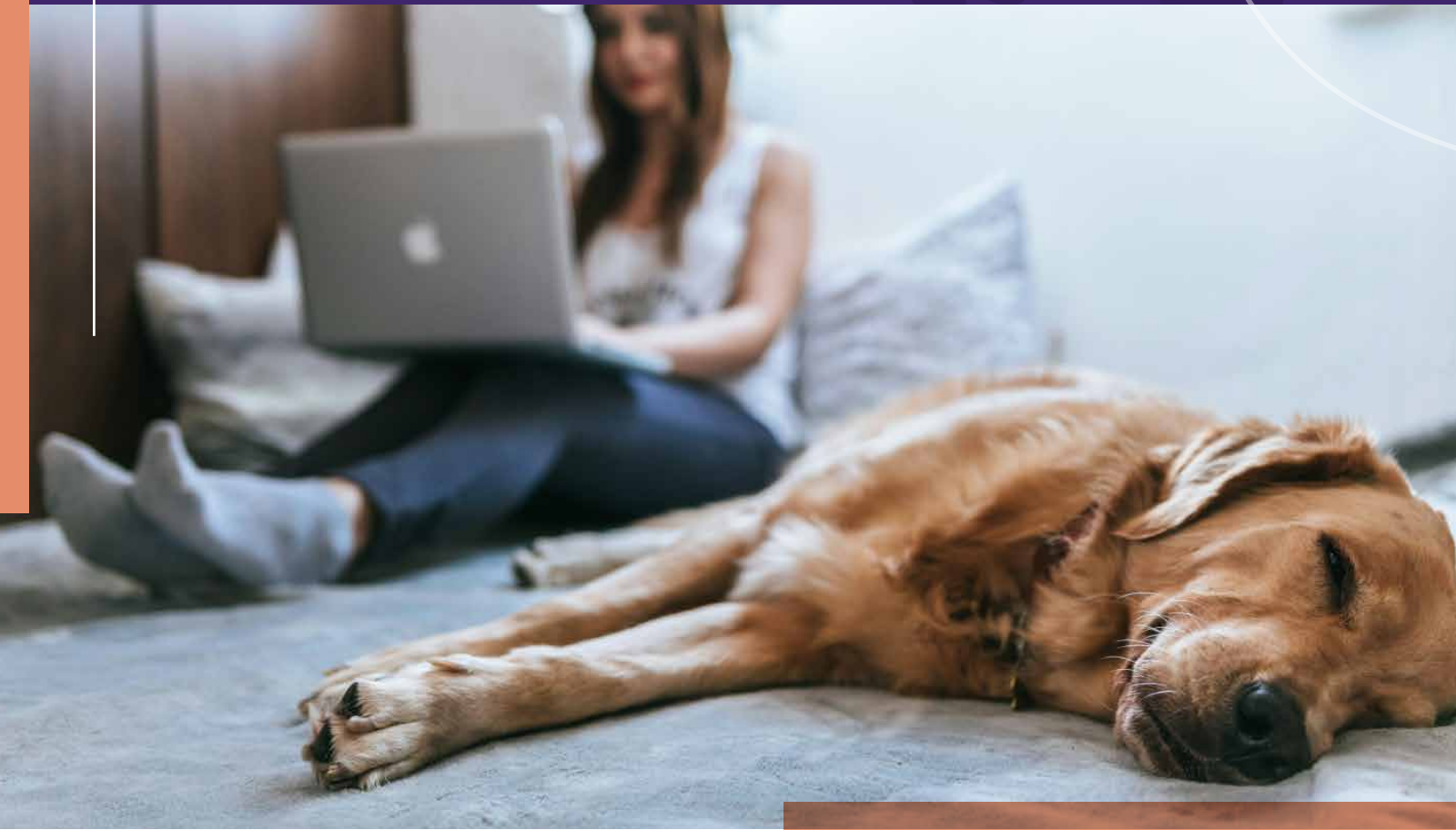
# Cats Are Masters of Communication

Each sound conveys different messages, whether it's a call for dinner or a demand for attention. Ever feel like your cat is talking back? They probably are!

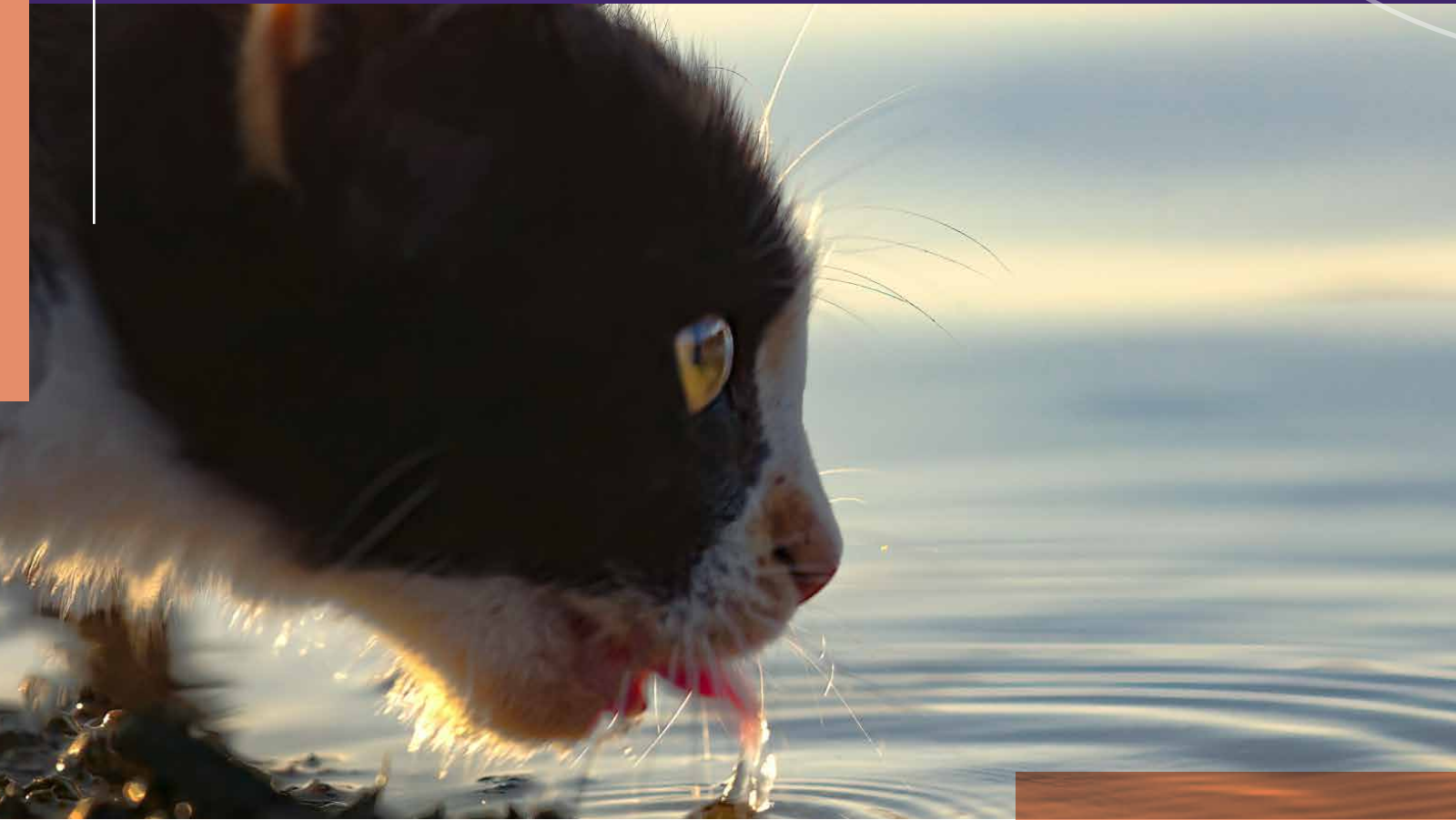
# Dogs Can Dream Too

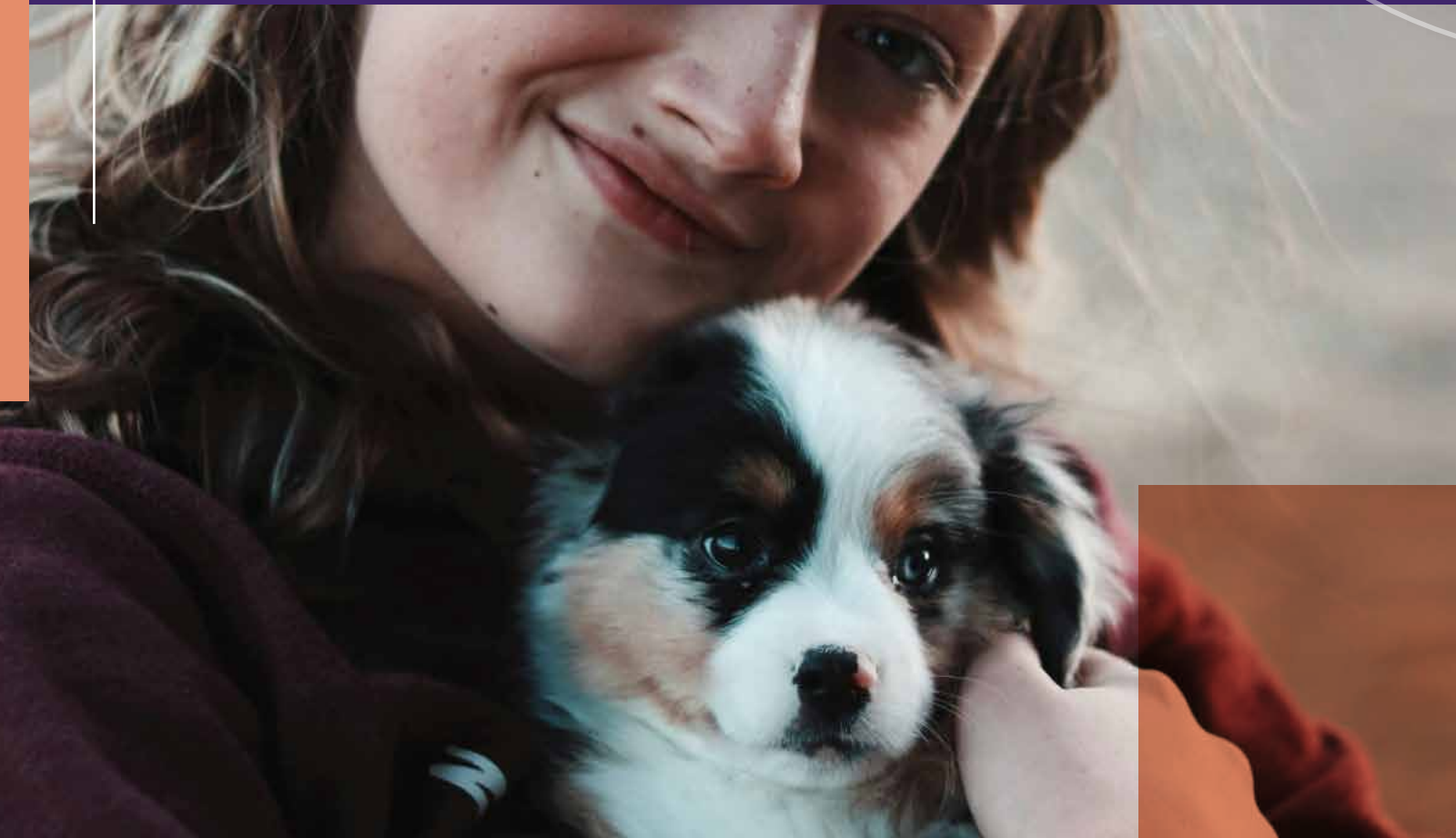
# Cats Have a Unique Drinking Technique
